**PLAINTIFFS' MOTION FOR FINAL APPROVAL
OF CLASS ACTION SETTLEMENT**

Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 23(e)(2) ("Rule 23"), Plaintiffs Rose Clarkson, June Mack, Valerie Hicks, Carrie Devers, Theresa Culver, Amy Capodici, Georgeann Roberts, and Pamela Silver ("Plaintiffs"), individually and on behalf of all others similarly situated, respectfully move this Court for final approval of the class action Settlement that this Court preliminarily approved on April 13, 2026.

Class Representatives respectfully request this Court:

1. Grant final certification of the Settlement Class for settlement purposes pursuant to Rule 23(a) and (b)(3);
2. Finally appoint Rose Clarkson, June Mack, Valerie Hicks, Carrie Devers, Theresa Culver, Amy Capodici, Georgeann Roberts, and Pamela Silver as Class Representatives;

3. Finally appoint Elena A. Belov of Almeida Law Group LLC, Marc H. Edelson of Edelson Lechtzin LLP, and Jonathan S. Mann of Pittman, Dutton, Hellums, Bradley & Mann, P.C. as Class Counsel pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 23(g);
4. Approve the requested attorneys' fees of \$841,666.66 and reimbursement of litigation expenses in the amount of \$9,550.99 to Class Counsel;
5. Finally approve the requested Service Award of \$3,500.00 for each Class Representative, for a total of \$28,000.00;
6. Find that the Notice met the requirements of Rule 23(c)(2)(B);
7. Find that the terms of the Settlement Agreement are fair, reasonable, and adequate and are approved, adopted, and incorporated by the Court;
8. Direct the Parties, their respective attorneys, and the Claims and Settlement Administrator to consummate the Settlement in accordance with the [Proposed] Final Approval Order and Judgment and the terms of the Settlement Agreement;
9. Resolve all claims as to all Parties and Class Members in this action and issue a Final Approval Order and Judgment; and
10. Dismiss the lawsuit with prejudice and without costs, except as provided in the Settlement Agreement.

WHEREFORE premises considered, Plaintiffs request that this Court grant this motion, as well as *Plaintiffs' Motion for Attorneys' Fees, Costs, and Service Awards*, filed concurrently herewith.
